The University of Education Indonesia consistently monitors and supports the career development of its graduates through a tracer study system and alumni career development services.

## **Tracer Study Reports by Study Program**

UPI conducts annual tracer studies to determine the career paths and achievements of its graduates, including the percentage of graduates working in their field, the length of time spent waiting for employment, and the relevance of their competencies. ## **Alumni Career Development Services**
