## SUMMARY OF ANNEX 17: BLENDED LEARNING OR DISTANCE LEARNING ACHIEVEMENTS

MP-BE has effectively implemented blended learning as outlined in the 2024 Academic Implementation Guidelines of UPI (See UPI-Annex 2.3.4.). This learning model combines face-to-face (60%) and online learning modalities (40%), designed to offer greater flexibility and accessibility in the educational process. Blended learning at UPI leverages digital modules and a variety of interactive online platforms to support students' independent and collaborative learning experiences. This approach aligns with UPI's emphasis on Outcome-Based Education (OBE) and its commitment to fostering innovation in teaching methods. By utilizing a blended learning format, the program ensures that students not only master the core concepts of biology education but also acquire essential skills in technology integration, critical thinking, and self-directed learning. Furthermore, this method supports UPI's vision of becoming a leading and outstanding university by preparing graduates who are adaptable to global challenges and technological advancements in education.
