

## **SUMMARY OF ANNEX 20: INTERNATIONAL OFFICE REGULATIONS**

UPI has regulations to regulate the registration and acceptance of foreign students managed by the Directorate of International Affairs (DIA). The Directorate of International Affairs (DIA) and the Directorate of Education UPI admit foreign students through institutional and individual partnerships. Separate regulations establish standards for providing education to overseas students. (<https://dia.upi.edu/international-students/admission/apply-for-master-or-doctorate/>).

MP-BE accepts foreign student registrations to study. In 2020 there was one foreign student from Accra, Ghana Africa who registered and studied in a study program named Mawutor Kwame Ahiabu, but due to the conditions of the Covid-19 pandemic, the student concerned could not complete / pass his studies at MP-BE.

However UPI has an internationalization program that is regulated for students during their studies, students have the chance to participate in summer courses abroad or international student mobility, either self-funded or through scholarships. Additionally, students may attend international seminars to present findings from their research, gaining valuable exposure and feedback from the global academic community. MP-BE collaborates with international partners, offering a double degree program with Okayama University and a student exchange program.
